From your Pastor The public debate on redefining the meaning of Marriage is increasing in intensity. You as Catholic people need to receive a clear explanation of the Church's teaching about the nature of Marriage. Therefore the bishops of Sydney have brought out a Pastoral Letter on this subject. It is called, "Marriage: One Man and One Woman in a Covenant of Love and Life". This letter from the bishop will be read at Mass today. Copies of it are made available in the foyer of the church for you to take home. Because of this pastoral letter, I have not written any other reflection for this week.

Catholic Inquiry

Your family may have non-Catholics as well as Catholics. The non-Catholic member of your family may like to know more about Catholic faith and practice. You many know of other non-Catholic families interested in learning about Catholicism, with or without the intention of joining the Church. I am starting a program called, "Catholic Inquiry" for all such seekers. It will start with a Guided Tour of the Church at St Peter Chanel. It will be on Sunday 15 July at 2 PM. This tour will be repeated on Thursday, 19 July at 7 PM. You are welcome to bring interested people to one these sessions.

Parish Pastoral Council

Basically the role of Pastoral Council is to promote the Church's mission to live and communicate the love and values of Christ in the world around us.
