People from beyond boundaries meet Jesus



On New Year Day I have completed two years in Berala. In this last two years I have made new friends and have accomplished some of my vision and mission. I am grateful to many good colleges from the parish who have made it possible. Boxing Day was the 29th anniversary of my Ordination. I

celebrated the day with some of the priest friends who are Indian Missionaries, like me, in Australia. The constant reflection of such gatherings is that we are to make Christ present to the people entrusted to us as Messiah beyond boundaries. The Epiphany of the Lord which we celebrate today is also a reminder that as Christians, all of us are called to proclaim Jesus Christ as the saviour beyond all boundaries.

Through the birth of Jesus, our God has become very tangible. The babe born in Bethlehem was cuddly. Like any other child he also cried and smiled. He had to be fed and dandled. The shepherds could describe the colour of his eyes. Yes they could touch and feel their God now.

The mystery and universality of Jesus present to us in the Eucharist is the vision and strength of us Christians. I, like many of you, have happily crossed cultural, political, and geographical boundaries to proclaim Jesus Christ as Son of God and our Saviour.

On this day of Epiphany, I wish the nearness of Incarnated God to you all. As we all start a new year, may it be full of God experience.


