

From your Pastor

Baptism, an Initiation

Baptism of the Lord, which is celebrated as a feast today, reminds us of our own baptism. Our original sin and any other sins of a person are washed clean at Baptism. But Our Lord did not have any sins. So why did Jesus go for baptism by John, which is actually meant for the repentance of sin? John himself objects to baptising Jesus. But the answer Jesus gave was that he wants


to do what any righteous person would do. Therefore he wants to be baptised.



Since initiation requires the understanding and acceptance of the initiated person, it is done in three stages for babies. When a baptised baby grows up to the age of understanding, Holy Communion is offered. Then when the person is old enough to take up the ministry of proclaiming his Good News, the Sacrament of Confirmation celebrated by the bishop the anointing the initiated person with the Holy Chrism on the forehead.

What is the difference between Baptism and Christening? After the baptism with water, the child is christened through the anointing with Holy Chrism on the forehead. 'Christening' literally means 'anointing'. Jesus Christ means Jesus the anointed one. The formula of prayer the priest or deacon pronounces with action of anointing with Holy Chrism defines the meaning of this ritual. The celebrant of baptism says, "As Christ was anointed Priest, Prophet, and King, so you may live always as a member of his Body, sharing everlasting life". Through this anointing with Chrism, the baptised person is made another Christ. The newly baptised person, irrespective of the gender and age, becomes a priest. This might surprise some people. But it is true. All validly baptised and Christened people are priests and they are called to lead a life of Sacrificial Prayer. Through the Sacrificial Prayer a Christian intercedes between God and fellow human beings. The difference with ordained priests is that they are called to preside over the Holy Sacrifice of Eucharist. As Christened people we are also anointed to be Prophets. That means we assume to duty to speak God's language (language of love) and speak on behalf of God. To be King means living like an ideal king who will be at the service of his subjects always. So our Christian identity has three characteristics: priest, prophet, and service. These characters are imprinted on our very person for ever. Therefore once we are Christened we will always be Christians, no matter what.

17 January — Saint Anthony, Abbot. Memorial
